

李岚博士获中国人民大学中国语言文学学士、硕士;英国贝尔法斯特女王大学人类学博士。现任都柏林大学中国研究院讲师,讲授中国文化、当代中国社会、国际汉语等课程,并负责该院与都柏林大学孔子学院的教学与科研工作。李岚博士的研究主要在中国通俗宗教、爱中文化比较、国际汉语教学的本土化与电子化等方面。著有专著《Popular Religion in Modern China》、第一作者合著《Doing Business in China: Irish Experience》、《Doing Business in China: Irish Advantages and Challenges》、《国际汉语电子化模式探析》,发表中英文论文多篇,并主编了《The Teaching Pack on Chinese Culture and Language for Transition Year》、《Chinese for Short Course in Chinese Language and Culture》,均为爱尔兰中学汉语教育大纲教材。李岚博士自 2015 年任爱尔兰教学协会副会长、自 2019年任欧洲汉语教学协会副秘书长。

Dr. Lan Li received a BA and an MA degree in Chinese Language and Literature from Renmin University of China; a Ph.D. in anthropology from Queen's University, Belfast, UK. She is currently a lecturer in the Institute of for Chinese Studies at the University College of Dublin (UCD), teaching Chinese culture, contemporary Chinese society, international Chinese, and is responsible for teaching and research in both the Institute for Chinese Studies at UCD and the UCD Confucius Institute for Ireland. Dr. Li's research focuses on the popular religion in modern China, the comparison between Chinese and Irish culture, and the localisation and electronification of international Chinese teaching. She is the author of "Popular Religion in Modern China", and original author of "Doing Business in China: Irish Experience", "Doing Business in China: Irish Advantages and Challenges" and "An Analysis of the Application of Digital Methods to International Chinese Pedagogy". She has published many papers in Chinese and English. She is also the chief editor of "The Teaching Pack on Chinese Culture and Language for Transition Year" and "Chinese for Short Course in Chinese Language and Culture", both are textbooks for teaching Chinese language and culture as a subject on the curriculum of Irish postprimary schools. Dr. Li has been the vice president of the Irish Association for Chinese Teaching since 2015 and the deputy secretary general of the European Association for Chinese Teaching since 2019.
