Brief description of the main contents of the Seminar

The seminar aims at drawing attention on a topic which has so far occupied a marginal position in the general research on Chinese language teaching (CLT) and acquisition, i.e. the issue concerning the accessibility of CLT for learners with Specific Language Impairments (SLI).

The main aim of the seminar will be to share some considerations on the state of the art of this specific field of studies in China, in Italy and at an international level. Moreover, the seminar will provide participants with the opportunity to deepen their knowledge about accessible and inclusive CLT.

The seminar will start with a plenary session in the morning, with a series of on-site and/or online presentations carried out by international experts involved in research activities about Second Language Acquisition by learners with SLI. Afterwards, in the afternoon two parallel thematic workshops will be organized online.

Addressees: school teachers, PhD students, researchers and Professors, stakeholders with different backgrounds.
